- Kindly observe Al-Anon's Twelve Traditions when sharing.

I got to know the people at Fifth Third Bank very well, and they didn't even cringe when they saw me coming with my stack of ones every week.

Some of the moneymaking things that we did over the last year as a group have been:

- \$50.00 given to start a new Alateen group in Whitehall. Since then the group has decided to set aside \$200.00 per year to be used specifically for Alateen at their request. If the money is not used it will be donated to KOMIAC.
- In December, we collected "spare change". Our grand total was \$128.36. This was given to Central Office along with the group's quarterly donation.
